



## EXPECTATION OF BEHAVIOR

**Squash & Beyond WORLD** expects that the campers who participate come to the program willingly and with the understanding that they will be training hard, participating in social activities, acting responsibly and showing respect for one another. Campers will be working with professional coaches who have high expectations for the behavior of their participants. It is expected that all students come prepared to put forth their best effort.

**COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE:** Your tour will be exciting, fun, challenging, and difficult at times.

We expect you will:

- Follow instructions
- Be open to meeting new people, trying new things and challenging yourself
- Work to maintain a positive attitude
- Be willing to make mistakes and learn from them
- Show respect to your coaches and fellow campers
- Embrace people's differences as sources of learning and personal growth
- Demonstrate appropriate language and behavior towards others
- Not bring alcohol, tobacco and drugs
- Prepare yourself physically

**EXPULSION:** Please understand that there are certain problems that we will handle by sending the offender home. These include acts which seriously jeopardize the safety of self or other students, or which demonstrate that a student is a negative influence on the community as a whole. We will not let one student's actions negatively affect other students' enjoyment of the tour. We will try to give advance warnings and second chances but cannot guarantee them in the case of severe behaviors. Bullying of students or any type of stealing will not be tolerated. The use of non-prescription drugs, tobacco and tobacco products, or alcohol is inappropriate to our mission and will result in expulsion as would willful participation in unsafe behaviors such as sneaking away from the group at night. Any type of sexual harassment also falls into this category. In addition, if we determine that any information was misrepresented or not disclosed in a participant's application or required forms, we have the right to expel the participant. Expulsion from a tour will result in forfeiture of tuition as well as the application and transportation fees.

**I have read and understood the Expectations of Behavior. I understand that if I am unable to meet these expectations, I may be expelled from the tour and returned home at my own expense or the expense of my parents.**
